

## 2021-2022 Lincoln Elementary School Supply List

It is helpful to remove supplies from packaging prior to bringing them to school. Please help us by labeling all items with your child's name.

### Student Supply Needs by Grade: *\*Please note that items may need replenished throughout the year.*

#### Kindergarten

- o 1 book bag (no wheels)
- o 1 hard plastic school box (8.5" x 5")
- o 1 soft fabric zipper pouch
- o 4 packs of 24 crayons
- o 1 pair children's scissors
- o 20 pencils, sharpened
- o 2 large pink erasers
- o 6 glue sticks
- o 1 bottle Elmer's white school glue
- o 1 one inch 3-ring binder
- o 1 pack black dry erase markers

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade

- o 20 #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- o 1 box crayons
- o 1 box colored pencils or markers
- o 12 glue sticks
- o 1 pair student scissors
- o 1 large zipper pencil pouch (not a box)
- o 3 pocket folders with prongs – 1 each red, blue, yellow
- o 1- 1" heavy-duty binder with front/back pockets
- o 1 package 5 tab dividers for binder
- o 1 zipper pouch for 3-ring binder
- o 1 two-pocket folder, student choice of design
- o 2 pencils, sharpened
- o 4 black dry erase markers
- o 1 pair headphones or earbuds

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Grade

- o 1 white binder with clear sleeve on front and pockets inside; ½"
- o 1 binder; 1"
- o 1 spiral notebook; wide ruled (any color)
- o 1 pencil pouch with zipper and three holes (to insert in binder)
- o 1 pack 24 crayons (no larger)
- o 1 plastic school box; 8" x 5"
- o 1 pair student scissors
- o 10 glue sticks (no bottled glue)
- o 12 pencils (minimum), sharpened
- o 1 pink eraser
- o 2 two-pocket folders (1 blue, 1 red) with 3-hole punch to put in ½" binder
- o 2 boxes tissues
- o 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- o 5 dry erase markers
- o 1 pair Headphones (for computer)

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

- o 1 pair headphones or earbuds
- o 1" white binder with clear front pocket
- o 5 plastic folders with prongs – 1 each yellow, red, green, blue and orange
- o 2 plastic folders, student choice Design
- o 1 yellow spiral notebook
- o 1 spiral graph notebook or 1 package loose leaf grid paper
- o 1 package tab dividers, 8 each
- o 3 twelve-packs pencils, sharpened
- o 2 large pink erasers
- o 2 red pens
- o 1 24-pack of crayons or 1 12-pack of colored pencils
- o 1 pack markers
- o 2 highlighters, any color
- o 2 black Sharpie markers
- o 4 black dry-erase markers
- o 4 large glue sticks
- o 1 ruler with inches and centimeters
- o 1 pair scissors
- o 1 package wide-ruled notebook paper
- o 1 protractor
- o 2 zippered pouches, 1 large (art supplies), 1 small (pencils)
- o 1 pair clean, old socks for dry erasing

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

- o 1 pack 24 crayons
- o 2 or more block erasers with name written on them
- o 10 glue sticks
- o 2 packs of #2 pencils, sharpened
- o 1 ruler with inches and centimeters (no bendy rulers)
- o 1 pair student scissors
- o 1 large school box or pouch that fits in desk
- o 2 wide ruled spiral notebooks
- o 2 boxes tissues
- o 2 red pens
- o 1 pack highlighters
- o 1 pack dry erase markers
- o 1 clean, old sock for dry erasing
- o 5 two-pocket folders
- o 3 two-pocket plastic folders with 3 prongs

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

- o 1 pair earbuds
- o 2 plastic 2-pocket folder
- o 3 1½" binder with pockets and 5 dividers
- o plenty of pencils and erasers
- o crayons and/or markers
- o 2 zippered pouches, 1 large (for art), 1 small (pencils) – No hard pencil boxes
- o 1 highlighter
- o 2-3 dry-erase markers

#### Laakso/Longville

- o Dry erase
- o Velcro with sticky back
- o Liquid glue or glue sticks
- o 1- two pocket folder
- o Snack supplies (paper plates, cutlery, plastic cups, plastic bowls, etc.)
