1. Course Completion

*Elective units must include one or any combination of world language, fine arts, business, career-technical education, family and consumer sciences, technology, agricultural education or English language arts, mathematics, science or social studies courses not otherwise required.

**Fine Arts credits may be taken in grades 7-12. Fine Arts credits taken in Grades 7 and 8 may not count for high school credit unless they meet ODE guidelines. Students who follow a career-technical pathway are exempt from the Fine Arts requirement.

2. Competency Demonstration

Students must demonstrate competency in **<u>both</u> ELA and Math** in one of the following ways:

3. Readiness Demonstration

Students will demonstrate readiness for their post-high school paths by earning two seals that allow them to demonstrate important foundational and well-rounded academic and technical knowledge, professional skills, social and emotional competencies, and leadership and reasoning skills. At least one seal earned must be a state-defined seal. Students must turn in an intent form indicating which seals s/he wants to work on each school year.

Community Service Seal	 Students can earn the Community Service Seal through <u>one</u> of the following ways: Complete 40* hours by April 1 of senior year, recommended to be completed in increments of 10 hours per school year; a minimum of 10 hours need to be completed per organization; all hours need to be completed with a public or private organization (not with a family member); all hours must be verified on the <u>district-provided form</u> and returned to the office for tracking purposes. *The number of hours will be prorated for students who transfer in after freshman year. OR Complete a student-proposed plan for a service project to be approved no later than September 30 of the senior year. 			
Fine and Performing Arts Seal	 Students can earn the Fine & Performing Arts Seal through <u>one</u> of the following ways: Complete two years in a curricular instrumental or vocal music course with a grade of A or B for each year. OR Complete two courses beyond Exploration of Art with a grade of A or B for each course. OR Complete two courses beyond Introduction to Acting with a grade of A or B for each course. Student Engagement Seal	 Students can earn the Certified Student Engagement Seal through one of the following ways: Participate in and show commitment in 2 seasons of the same sport or 4 seasons of various sports with at least 80% verified participation OR Participate in and show commitment (at least 80% participation) in 2 years of school-approved clubs OR Participate in and show commitment to marching band or other extracurricular bands or ensembles for at least two seasons with at least 80% verified participation OR Participate in and show commitment to M&Ms or other extracurricular choirs or vocal ensembles for at least two seasons with at least 80% verified participation OR Participate in and show commitment to the extracurricular theatre arts for at least two productions with at least 80% verified participation OR Participate in and show commitment to student leadership or student government for 2 years OR Complete a student-proposed plan for an outside club, activity or sport such as 4H, scouts, etc., and show membership and at least 80% verified participation.
