When the Mundorfs where deciding how to memorialize their mother (thirty years after her death), they realized that a library with materials related to trauma would be a perfect way to provide resources to the students in our district. When their mother passed away, they were students at Preston Elementary School. Although they received support from their teachers, counselors, staff, and friends, there were few library materials to help them work through their feelings of loss and grief. When they researched to see what materials were currently available to help current students and their families, they discovered there was still a void in this area. By reaching out to friends and family and establishing a social media page related to this mission, the Mundorfs were able to raise the funds needed to buy the resources for Rachel's Library. They purchased materials related to all kinds of trauma and created a warm and welcoming room at Preston where students and staff can find materials related to the trauma they are experiencing in their lives. It is the hope of the Mundorfs that Rachel's Library will continue to expand and find homes in many other buildings in our school district.
