The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution was founded on October 11, 1890 and its historical, educational, and patriotic objectives have not changed in 125 years. Daughters across the nation are about community service, preserving history, educating children, as well as honoring and supporting those who serve our nation. The Community Classroom Committee was established by the National Society in June of 2016 to encourage Daughters to volunteer to provide additional support to teachers and children in classrooms in their own communities throughout the nation, and also overseas.

The Cuyahoga Falls Chapter DAR has set out to achieve the objectives of the Community Classroom Committee by providing support to both Price Elementary School and Cuyahoga Falls High School. Since 2017, they have supported Price Elementary School by providing \$400.00 in school supplies for staff and students.
