1. Complete 21 course credits

Social Studies –
Ohio's minimum course requirements
within the three required units

- 2019 and 2020 – $\frac{1}{2}$ unit in American history (CFHS students take 1 unit)
- 2019 and 2020 – $\frac{1}{2}$ unit in American government
- 2021 – an additional $\frac{1}{2}$ unit in world history and civilizations (CFHS students take 1 unit)

2. Three Graduation Pathways



At least 18 points on state tests



Industry-recognized credential **AND** a work-readiness score on WorkKeys



Remediation-free score on ACT or SAT



Three Graduation Pathways



At least 18 points on state tests



Earn a minimum of **four points** in English tests

Earn a minimum of **four points** in math tests

Earn a minimum of **six points** in science and social studies tests

Additional **four points** selected from any of the content areas



Classes of 2019 and Beyond: Earn 18 points on state tests


